## Annual Performance and Costume Commitment Forms Due October 30

The 2019 Annual Performance and Costume Commitment Form has been distributed in students' mail folders. Please indicate if your child will be participating in the Annual Performance in June. If so, please determine the costumes you wish to order. Forms must be turned into the front desk by October 30, 2018.

You may pay the entire balance

with the commitment form or you may choose a payment system of one-half of the costume and wig payment by October 30. The remaining balance must be paid by November 29, 2018.

Costumes are ordered during December and January for June recitals. The price of costumes also includes tights (pink and/or tan), costume alterations and

possible hairpieces or small props. Curly wigs are standard for ages 3-6 combination classes. These curly wigs are a one-time purchase and will be used every year. The curly wigs must be purchased through Fusion Dance only, as we need all wigs to be uniform. Costume and wig payments are not refundable after orders have been placed with supply companies.

Students will be measured for costumes during classes in December.



## Don't Forget Your Dance Shoes!

At the beginning of the dance year, some families like to try out dance classes before they make an investment in dance shoes. If you have not already purchased shoes, now is the time to make this purchase for your dancers.

Students are required to wear specific shoes to ensure safety and ease of motion.

- In combination classes, girls wear pink ballet shoes, tan buckle tap shoes and tan jazz gore boots.
- In combination classes, boys wear black ballet shoes, black tap shoes and black jazz gore boots.
- The Boys Only class uses black tap shoes and black jazz gore boots.



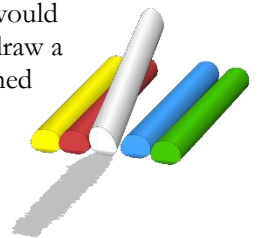
- The Adaptive Dance class students may wear clean tennis shoes or tan jazz gore boots.
- Ballet classes need pink canvas ballet shoes with the elastic straps fitted to the dancer and sewn in the shoe.
- Tan Bella shoes are used in musical theatre and lyrical classes.
- Tap Technique needs black tie taps. Competition Tap needs a specialized black tie tap.
- Hip-hop shoes must be clean tennis shoes for class; however, a style of uniform shoes will be selected for the Annual Performance.
